A. OPENING PROCEDURES

b. Out of School Time Summer Program – Jessica Carrillo and Delia Salcido

Jessica and Delia presented the first ever Summer Camp Academy and Summer Kinder Camp Academy for 2022 made possible through new funding by the state with Summer Kinder Camp Academy available for children enrolling in kindergarten for the 2022-23 school year. c. Consolidated Application Report for Title III

Bonner presented and explained data regarding funding for Title I Part A (formerly based on the number of free/reduced lunch applications, Title II (professional development), and Title III (based on Limited English Proficient and Immigrant status). The district has not qualified for Title III Immigrant funding since 2019. The district has spent its funding on two bilingual assistants, licenses for Rosetta Stone, Guided Language Acquisition Design (GLAD) training for certificated staff, and licenses for Imagine Learning.

d. 2022-23 LCAP Goals and Action Steps Summary – Draft

Bonner requested “educational partner” (formerly “stakeholder”) input for the 2022-23 Local Control Accountability Plan (LACP). The five points are 1) accelerate learning, 2) professional development, 3) social-emotional learning support, 4) strengthening student connectedness, and 5) implementation of safety protocols for in-person instruction. Funding for transitional kindergarten, instructional assistants hired in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, alternative school instructional

supports, student well-being initiatives, student mental health initiatives, student attendance improvement, and parent engagement were all reduced. The public is invited to review the draft at the district website and submit questions to the superintendent at:
