

Drug Free Workplace Policy

PURPOSE

Ramona Paving and Construction Corporation (RPCC) is committed to protecting the safety, health, and well being of all employees and other individuals in our workplace. RPCC is committed to providing an alcohol and drug free environment and encourages our employees to voluntarily seek help with drug and alcohol problems.

STATEMENT OF POLICY

Any individual who conducts business for RPCC, is applying for a position or is conducting business on RPCC's property is covered by this drug free workplace policy. The policy includes, but is not limited to managers, supervisors, full-time and part-time employees, independent contractors, volunteers, interns and applicants.

The drug free workplace policy is intended to apply whenever anyone is representing or conducting business for RPCC. REGULATIONS
