Educational Priorities for 2020-21 School Year

BACKGROUND:

On March 4, 2020, the Governor of California declared a State of Emergency due to the outbreak and spread of the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), and on March 19, 2020, the Governor of California issued an executive order directing all individuals living in the State of California to stay home or at their place of residence, with limited exception, until further notice. Santee School District closed its schools on March 16, 2020, and distance learning was implemented upon return from Spring Break on Monday, April 13.

Effective June 16, updated San Diego County Public Health Orders allow schools to hold classes or school business operations on school campuses provided the school complies with industry guidance on schools and school-based programs issued by the California Department of Public Health. In preparation for the safe return of students and staff on the first day of school for the 2020-21 school year, August 19, a District planning committee has been researching these public health guidelines. This planning committee will take direction from the Board of Education and administration to develop the District's re-opening plan.

In a recent survey of current Santee School District families, 98% of responding families (73% total response rate) stated their children would return to a school campus in the fall and 2% requested additional information for an alternative school option (e.g. homeschool). Based on this data, administration recommends the Board of Education discuss the educational priorities associated with the return of students on August 19.
