Discussion of Facilities Planning and Approval of Provisional Plan for Non-Capital Improvement Program Facility Needs Projects

BACKGROUND:

In 2006, the District embarked upon a new Capital Improvement Program (CIP) then estimated at \$130 million. Many of the projects in the original CIP plan have been completed but a few remain to be done. In addition, the District has numerous other facility needs not included in the original CIP plan.

Tonight, Administration will present a report on facility needs and a provisional plan for initiating non-CIP facility projects in phases. The report will include the following:

- CBEDs Enrollment Trends
- Estimated Enrollment Impact for Future Residential Developments
- CIP Project Costs for Completed Projects
- Review of Priority Listing for Remaining CIP Projects
- Other Non-CIP Facility Needs and Provisional Phasing Plan

RECOMMENDATION:
